Club Referee Policy & Registration

- Copy of 2015 Policy and Requirements received
- Copy of 2015 Policy and Requirements given to Club Referees
- Existing and New Club Referees understand the requirements
- Club understands the requirements for Single team divisions
- Green Shirt or Orange Vest held by Club for Club Referee
- Understand and accept the Clubs Responsibilities under this Policy
- Code of Conduct given to Club Referees
- Agree that Club Referees are not to wear the Official Uniform of the SAASRA

Team Sheets

- Clubs has the current Team sheets for 201 2016
- Accept Club will be fined if the Team sheets are not completed or not legible
- Coach and Team Manager/Trainer must be named on the Team Sheet
- Club Marshalls and Club Officials must provide full name and pass number
- Team sheets must be returned to the League by the Wednesday after fixture

(tick reqd)

Club Marshall - by both Home and Away Club - all teams

- Required to have one Club Marshall wearing the vest and ID at every game
- Understand Club Marshal to be adjacent the Technical Area at ALL times
- Club has briefed the Club Marshall/Officials on duties & Code of Conduct
- Club Marshall must be visible to the Referee at all times during the match.
- To escort the Referee to and from the field, or as instructed by the Referee.
- Comply with the Referees instructions and assist the Referee as required
- Ensure Clubs Match Representatives remain in Technical Area
- Support the Referees instructions to the persons in the Technical Area
- Club is responsible for the Conduct of all members involved in Match duties (Coaches, Players, Team Manager, Trainer, Substitutes, Officials etc)

Club Officials - (this is in addition to the Club Marshall - by both Home & Away Clubs)

- Senior Fixtures Only** - Two Club Officials adjacent the pitch at all times
- Must Wear the Club Officials ID pass provided by the League
- Club Officials comply with Code of Conduct & complete the duties required
- Role is to assist the Club Marshall in their duties with the Match Officials.
- Responsible for controlling the Conduct of Club members & spectators

Club Officials/Committee Members

- ALL Club Officials are responsible for the Conduct of their members and spectators
- The Club agrees to abide by the requirements set by the SAASL.

Players Code of Conduct

Clubs have provided all players with a copy of Code of Conduct
 Club will also ensure Players abide by the Code of Conduct
 Understand any breaches will result to sanctions against Club and Player
 ALL Team Captains must wear a Captain's Arm Band
 Substitutes remain near or in the technical area & comply with Referee

Coach's Code of Conduct

Our Coaches are to be named on the Team sheet at every fixture
 ALL our Coaches will abide by the Code of Conduct
 Club is responsible for Conduct of all Coaches
 Coaches understand requirement to stay in Technical Area at all times.

Club Members & Spectators

Club to provide a Spectators Line as per the Competition Rules
 Must be the full length/both sides of the pitch and as detailed in the Competition Rules
 Club is fully responsible for Conduct of ALL members and spectators

Technical Area – (Coaches box)

Technical Areas are provided by our Club as per the Competition Rules
 Separate areas must be provided for Home and Away Clubs

Registration of Players

Our Club will only play duly registered players
 Our Club will abide by the SAASL Registration processes
 Surcharges may apply on Registrations required within 7 days
